

Understanding the Baptist Movement

A study intensive will operate again in Tasmania in 2021 for anyone wanting to better understand the principles that lie behind the four hundred year old Baptist movement.

The intensive is suitable for all APL and RPL pastors who have not previously studied Baptist Principles formally. This intensive will not provide the depth and detail available through a full unit of study.

The intensive is also available to anyone interested to know more about Baptists in a post-denominational era.

Study intensive components

1. Reading

- Course text: Nigel Wright, *Challenge to Change, A Radical Agenda for Baptists*, Kingsway Publication, 1991 (copies are available on loan free of charge)
- Course notes – three units (about 30 pages)

2. One-day workshop

- Saturday 22 May, 10am-3pm, 2020 ***Come early ready to start on time.***

- byo lunch, hot drinks provided
- there is a coffee machine available, \$2 per cup
- four sessions:
 - Origins & Expansion;
 - Baptist Principles;
 - Applying Baptist Principles Today (two sessions).

3. Assessment

Assessment is only required by those completing UBM for their pastoral registration.

Assessment will be based on:

- A signed statement that the course text and course notes have been fully read;
- Full attendance at the one-day seminar;
- Satisfactory completion of the 500 word assignment: *Discuss the application of one chapter of the course text Challenge to Change to Tasmanian Baptists today; and*
- Payment of fees.

The fees for this study unit are \$20.00. Fees provide students with a small folder of notes and tuition.
